Artificial intelligence, birth control used to curb Geraldton pigeon numbers - ABC News	Leo has written to the ABC and Eric Wolf from Ovocontrol, Annolytics LLC Pigeon Control Company about making it clear that it is FERAL Pigeons that are being targeted for the sterilisation program. Currently no response from ABS, Eric Wolf replied with the comments noted for future published documentation.
